Tavistock, our nearest town, is filled with unique boutique style shops, great cafés and restaurants. With an indoor Pannier Market and a regular farmers market it is so easy to while away a few hours.

Dartmoor National Park is the largest and wildest area of open country in Southern England, but it is so much more than that. You can access it easily on foot, by bike, on horseback or by car. It makes a fantastic day out for free!

Enjoy the Dartmoor Ponies and indulge in a cream tea in one of the historical villages or visit one of the many National Trust properties close by.

For the active there's a variety of off-road cycle tracks including The Tamar Trails, Drake's Trail and The Granite Way. Canoe the River Tamar, go tree surfing or indoor barn climbing. All of these activities are within fifteen minutes of Woodovis.



...and further afield



Steam trains and beautiful river and sea trips make great holiday memories. Park free and enjoy the spectacular train ride to Looe or Plymouth, Britain's Ocean City, or make time for a trip up the River Dart on an historic paddle steamer.

A holiday to the West Country would not be complete without a trip to the seaside. Extensive white sandy beaches, small rocky coves, big rolling waves and small fishing ports. The choice is yours, north and south coasts are both within easy reach.



National Trust and English Heritage properties make a great day out whatever the weather; from King Arthur's Castle at Tintagel to Finch Foundry, still driven by water power. Cotehele House and Sir Francis Drake's Buckland Abbey, both with magnificent grounds, are close by too.

Indoor and outdoor days include; The National Marine Aquarium, Dartmoor Zoological Park, Pennywell Farm and Dingles Indoor Fairground Heritage Centre (the ghost train's really scary) all within easy reach. The Eden Project is a must to visit and The Lost Gardens of Heligan are amazing.

Although all our holiday homes have heating throughout, it is the Premier Robin and Deluxe Finch that have central heating and double glazing throughout, for your extra comfort.



We have a choice of four types of holiday home, some pet free for guests with allergies. All our holiday homes are fully heated and have full sized cooker and microwave, a flat screen TV/DVD and outside seating for dining alfresco. The Finch is our most affordable option but does not compromise on quality or comfort.

The Deluxe Finch gives you space and luxury, with comfortable sofa style seating and a built in fridge/freezer. A travel cot or highchair is available to use free of charge. The cost of your holiday includes all your gas, electricity, with your beds made up for you plus free use of the facilities on the park.

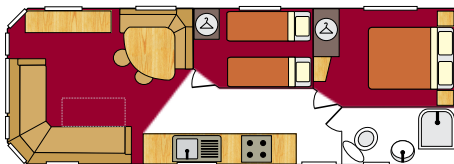

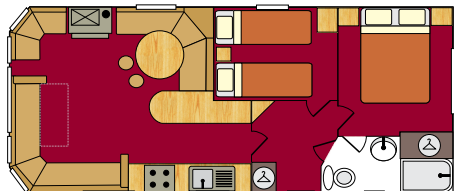
Layout examples...

28' x 12' 2 bedrooms 6 berth.



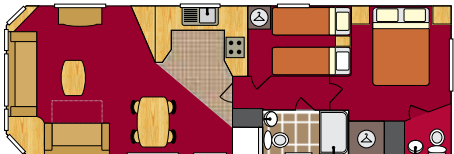
Super Finch - Sample Layout. Models vary.

Woodovis Cottage is an ideal choice for the ultimate pampering with all the facilities of the Park on your doorstep. It is a comfortable and cosy cottage that sleeps up to 3 people. There is a spacious king size bedroom (with TV) and a small single bedroom. Also upstairs you can enjoy a nice long soak in the bath which also has a shower over it.

As you would expect, it is fully centrally heated and doubled glazed, with a well equipped kitchen including a fridge, freezer, cooker and micro-wave. The relaxing lounge has a 32" TV/DVD player and a coal effect fire.



Outside you have your own private patio for eating alfresco, a garden to relax in and your own parking area. We would definitely recommend an early booking for Woodovis Cottage as it is extremely popular.

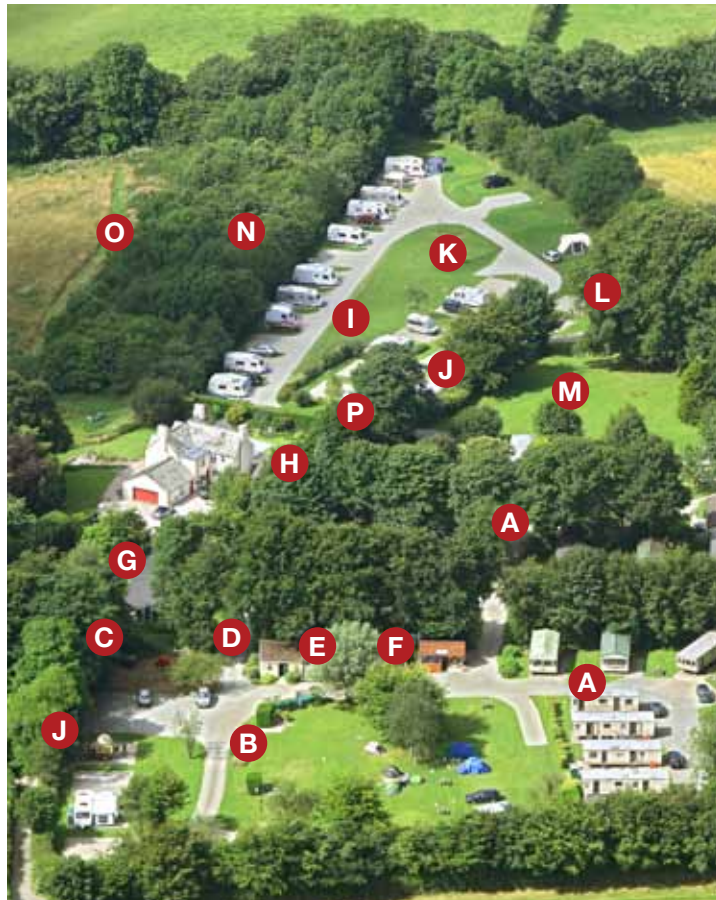

Glamping

Have all the fun of camping without the creepy crawlies or the packing up! All you need is some cooking gear and your bedding and you are good to go! You'll be snug as a bug in our cute and cosy double glazed camping pods.

Super Pods come with a booth style table and bench seating which converts into a comfortable double bed so you can lie back and watch TV in comfort. Two foldaway camping beds are also included. (Sleeps 2 adults & 2 small children).



Our Standard Pod is slightly more basic with no beds or TV. Think of it as a wooden tent! (Sleeps 2 adults). All our pods are equipped with electric socket, heater and lighting. Sorry, although our park is dog friendly, we do not accept pets in our pods.

Outside on the covered deck, a table and chairs are provided for dining al fresco and enjoying the night skies.

Of course, you have full use of all the facilities on the park too.

A more eco-friendly holiday without compromising on quality



We are very proud to have been awarded the 'GoldStar' as the most ecological Holiday Park in the UK by the world's leading Green Tourism organisation. This is endorsed with David Bellamy awarding us the top Gold Award for conservation.



Our planting of native species around the Park is designed to provide a rich habitat for many types of birds, mammals and insects. We do not use chemicals, like bleach, which are harmful to such creatures; instead we use ecological equivalents that work every bit as well.



Our main objective is to provide an outstanding level of quality and luxury whilst having little impact on the environment.

This has been achieved by a raft of measures including creating our own electricity, providing fresh water pumped from our own bore hole, heating the pool water with solar thermal energy and efficient recycling, plus the use of low energy lighting and sensors throughout the Park.



We support and promote local businesses wherever possible and are often told our produce, such as butter from the local dairy, eggs from our neighbours' free range chickens and Dartmoor meat from our local butchers, taste so much better than normal supermarket fare.



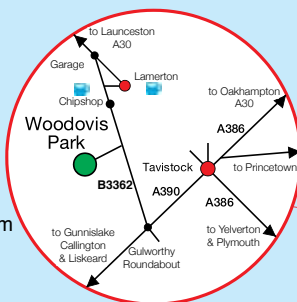

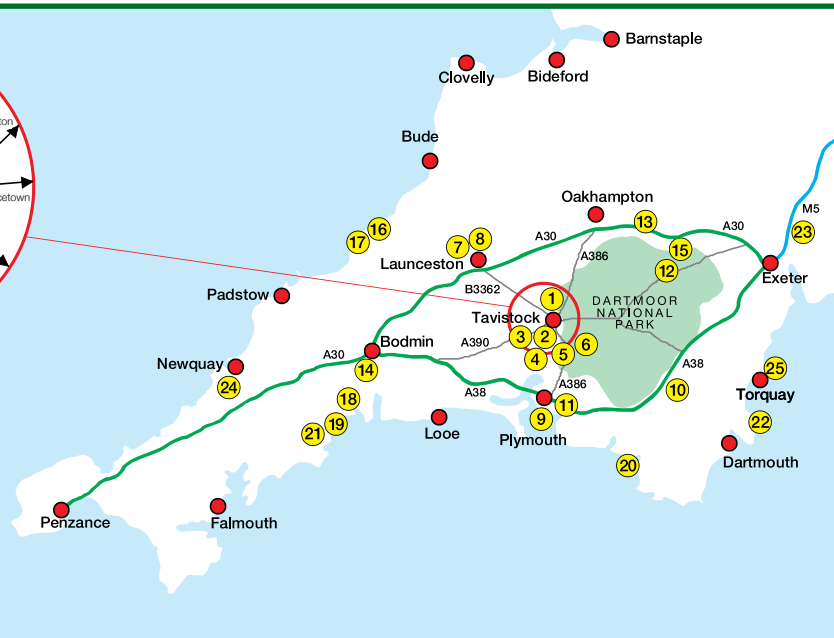
